Curricular Aspects

The College being affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), follows the curriculum designed and introduced by the Savitribai Phule Pune University. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is introduced by the University Grants Commission (UGC) from the year 2019-20 i.e. the starting year of the college. This provides more flexibility to frame different add-on, value based and skill based courses. This gives the college an opportunity to design and introduce appropriate career oriented and skill based short term courses for better placement opportunities. Many skill based courses can enhance the entrepreneurship skills among the students. The National Education Policy 2020 has now brought a praiseworthy change in the education. SPPU, in tune with this policy, has designed and introduced NEP 2020 based syllabus from the Academic Year 2024-25 for the UG courses under affiliated colleges.

Routine and continuous evaluation process offer better flexibility and brings more challenges to the teachers to inculcate innovative teaching techniques supported by ICT for improving student centric learning environment for the holistic progress of the students.

The college aims:

 use the new technologies, knowledge, methodologies with appropriate use of
 ICT in Teaching learning process.

Research, Innovations and Extension

The college is running only Undergraduate Courses but we encourage research activities and involvement in the extension activities for the benefit of the Society. The teacher quality and learning processes are improved through research and extension activities.

The college will always put efforts to encourage students as well as teaching faculties to involve in research and innovation related activities.

The College will aim:
